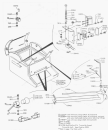


FIGURE 1. EXPLODED VIEW OF THE MECHANICAL ASSEMBLY

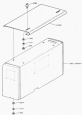
FIGURE 11. STRATEGIC PLANNING FOR A MULTI-SITE BUSINESS
