1. GENERAL

- a. The 194992 Modification Kit provides a Model 28 Typing Reperforator (LPR) or Perforator (LTPE) or a Model 28 Non-Typing Reperforator (LRPE or LARP) or perforator (LPE) with a 194993 Tape Guide. The 194993 Tape Guide is used to hold down the tape and prevent the tape from buckling and from creating a tape jam or loss of message.
 - b. This Modification Kit is not for units that must over feed hole.
- c. The 194992 Kit replaces the 146364, 159365, 163291 and 164963 Modification Kits.
 - d. The 194992 Kit consists of:

The 125011 Flat Washer provided with this kit may be discarded if the unit being modified is equipped with a power retracted (retractable slide) punch.

2. INSTALLATION (See Figures 1 and 2)

- a. Remove and discard the 146326, 154982, 154990, 162092, or 164514 Tape Guide and its mounting hardware, if the unit is so equipped.
 - b. Remove and retain the four 55063 Springs from the punch.
- c. Remove and retain the punch block assembly by removing and retaining the two mounting screws in the front plate of the punch and the two mounting screws in the rear plate of the punch.
- d. Remove the 151152 Screw (discard) and 110743 Lock Washer (retain) used to hold the 156012 Tape Biasing Spring and 172984 Spring Bracket (on power retracted units) to the punch block assembly.
 - e. Mount the 194993 Tape Guide to the punch block assembly.
- (1) If the unit being modified is equipped with a spring retracted (retractable bail) punch, reassemble in the following order: (Figure 1)

(2) If the unit being modified is equipped with a power retracted (retractable slide) punch, reassemble in the following order: (Figure 2)

194993	Tape Guide	(new)		Punch Block Casting	(retained)

Adjust the tape guide as shown in Section 3 of this specification at this point.


- f. Remount the punch block assembly using the retained mounting screws.
- g. Replace the four 55063 Springs removed in Step b.


